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Introduction

The Laboratory of Education Policy, Research, Development and Interuniversity Cooperation (ERDIC) of the University of Piraeus conducted the evaluation of the actions and of the inherent activities submitted online by the candidate Ambassador Schools. The evaluation comprised a total number of seven sections. Five of these sections were graded and focused on the schools' participation and relevant activities. It also comprised two sections that were not graded; i.e. a first obligatory part that related to the appointment of the candidate Senior and Junior Ambassadors, and the maximum use of the educational tools provided for the achievement of the programme's aims, as well as a last part that included each school's evaluation of the EPAS programme.

Each one of the five graded sections of the evaluation form corresponded to a certain number of accreditation points (as shown in Table 1. below; 100 credits in total) depending on the response of each candidate school to the particular aspects of the programme; i.e. the schools' action on the European Elections 2024 (25 credits); the action on one of three set topics (Environmental Crisis and Green Development, Digital Literacy and Transformation, and Equality and Anti-Discrimination) (25 credits); the action on Europe Day (25 credits); the creation and use of a digital/physical EU Info Point (10 credits); and the school's participation and actions in the Together.eu Volunteers' Net (15 credits). Guidance was provided within the whole duration of the programme for the evaluation process regarding the criteria and the sub-criteria for each one of the above five parts.

EPLO approved of the evaluation method, and the pre-formatted Final Activity Report was created for this purpose. Each candidate Ambassador School completed the Final Report Form analytically and submitted it. The schools were also asked to provide archives, photos, videos, and hyperlinks to corroborate the descriptions of their activities.

3rd General Lyceum of Nea Ionia, Attica

Description of actions and of related activities:

The students and teachers of the school worked effectively and creatively to design and implement engaging and productive actions and activities, which enhanced knowledge and facilitated skill acquisition. They collaborated with several institutions/partners in order to increase visibility. In particular:

-Action on the European Elections 2024

They created short videos and uploaded them on the tiktok platform in order to attract attention to the upcoming European Elections and encourage their fellow pupils and their parents to vote. The students studied the different institutions the EU consists of, how citizens can actively participate in politics and why voting in the Euro elections is important. They also attended different events ('Ask the president', student conference, video conference with a MEP) to become aware of the importance of citizenship. Finally, they wrote their own scripts, and recorded and uploaded their videos.

• Action on an EU-value campaign

They implemented an action about equality. The main idea of this action was to make the students and the members of the local community (colleagues, parents, citizens of Nea Ionia) aware of gender equality issues and of the importance of inclusivity, as well as to highlight the important steps and legislative actions the EU has already taken to tackle these issues. In light of this, the students and the teachers who participated in the program organized an afternoon open event in collaboration with the Municipality and the Conservatory of Nea Ionia in the Municipal Cinema ASTERA, where the students presented the research they had carried out on these issues through presentations, poetry, dancing and posters.

• Action on Europe Day

An event was held on April 26 to present the different actions they undertook within the EPAS program to the school community (students, teachers and parents). Its main aim was to promote participation in the European elections of 2024 and active citizenship. Therefore, the Ambassadors raised awareness by providing information about the EU and its institutions, and about the ways the Union creates opportunities for young people and promotes gender equality and inclusivity. The event, which was hosted in the school theatre, consisted of presentations, videos and games. They also cooperated with ELIAMEP-EUROPE DIRECT in order to make it more interactive and interesting for teenagers, who were their main audience.

• EU Info point

The school created a digital (in Instagram [epas_3olykeio](#)) as well as a physical info point, both of which were open to students and informed them about the different actions and activities of the EPAS programme as well as about the EU and its policies.

• Participation in the [together.eu](#)

They publicized the event they co-organized with the Municipality of Nea Ionia on March 20, 2024 on the topic "Building Bridges - We Are All Equal".

Best practice:

- Creation of short videos on tiktok to attract attention to the upcoming European elections and encourage fellow students and their parents to vote.
